Representatives from the City of New Haven will be available at Stetson branch for walk-in Rental Rebate enrollment every Tuesday this June.

To qualify, you need to be:

- ◆ 65 years of age or older (as of December 31, 2016)
- ◆ 100% disabled through Social Security
- ◆ 50 years or older and surviving spouse of qualified disabled spouse
- ◆ Totally disabled persons between 18-64 years of age

Please bring the following documents:

- ◆ All documents related to any and all income for 2015
- ◆ Rent receipts, or a letter notarized from the landlord if you do not have rent receipts
- ◆ Social Security benefits print out
- ◆ Utility print-outs
- ◆ Gas and Electric bills

NOTE: Have copies made of all paperwork. Submitted information will NOT be returned.
