 (1994) France/Vietnam

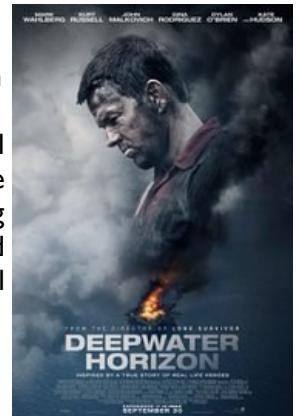
