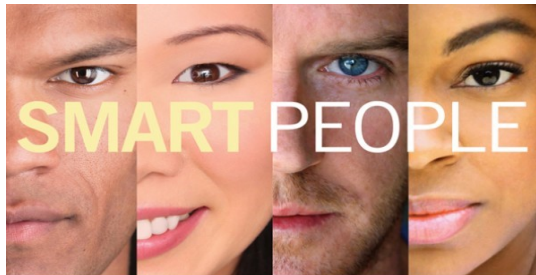

**A Film Series on Organizing and Resistance**

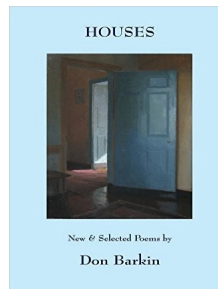
