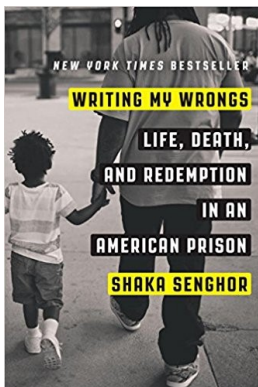

WRITING MY WRONGS: LIFE, DEATH AND REDEMPTION IN AN AMERICAN PRISON BY SHAKA SENGHOR
