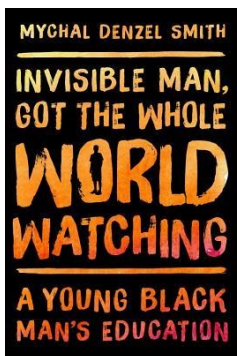

of Mychal Denzel Smith's thoughtful and engaging memoir.

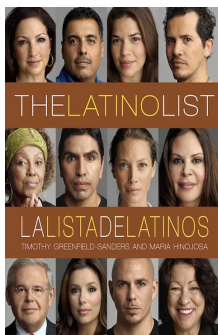

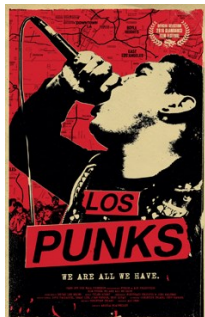

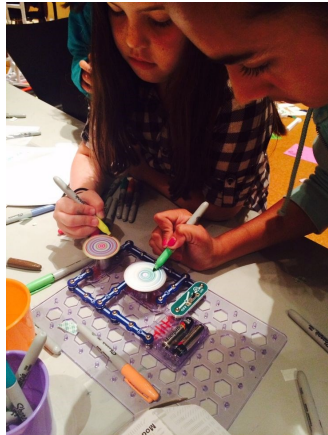
