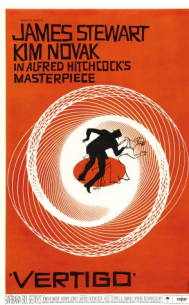

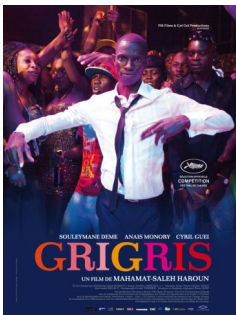
Glance at the World Through Film

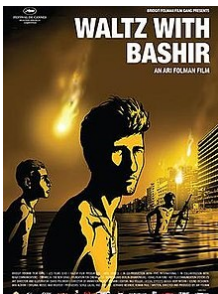


World Cinema Film Screening
