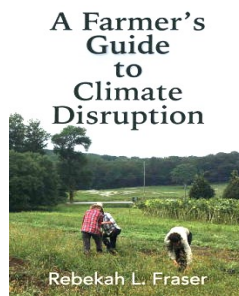
Creative Reuse
