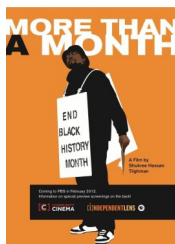

Join us for a Spanish-language Storytime!

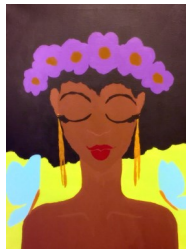


We'll read a story and sing some songs. Don't miss it!
