Imagine, create, and build with friends! We also have Mega blocks for our younger builders. *Families and children/teens of all ages welcome!*



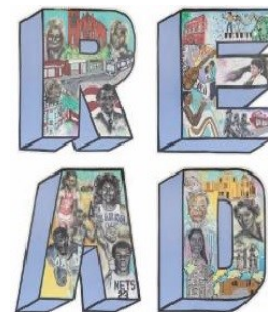
Girls Who Code!
