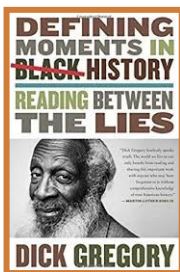


URBAN LIFE EXPERIENCE BOOK CLUB DISCUSSION

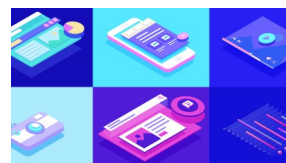
