New Haven's four neighborhood libraries open on Saturdays this summer!

City Librarian, Martha Brogan, announced that the New Haven Free Public Library's four neighborhood branches will be open on Saturdays from July 9 through August 27. The Fair Haven, Mitchell, Stetson, and Wilson libraries will be open from 10AM to 5PM during the summer months to offer residents a cool place to read, use the internet and relax. Ives Main Library will be closed on these Saturdays.

Please note the Library will be closed on Saturday, July 2 and Monday, July 4 for the Independence Day holiday and will reopen on Tuesday, July 5. The Library will also close on Monday, July 25 for an all staff training day to better serve you and will reopen the following day, Tuesday, July 26.

In support of the Mayor's initiative to make New Haven known as "The City That Reads," New Haven Free Public Library launches a summer learning challenge for pre-K to teens. New this year, the library is introducing the ability to track summer reading minutes online and earn points for end-of-summer rewards using Wandoo Reader. The Library is also launching a new digital service, the <u>Open eBooks app</u>, which is available to all school-age kids who attend New Haven Public Schools. Learn more about both programs.
