CITY OFFICIALS OFFER 'BEAT THE HEAT' OPTIONS IN THE FACE OF HOT WEATHER FORECAST

New Haven – City officials with the Office of Emergency Management, Department of Parks, Recreation, and Trees, and New Haven Free Public Library today offered residents helpful suggestions and possible 'beat the heat' options in the face of forecast hot weather the rest of the week.

All residents are encouraged to stay hydrated, wear loose-fitting clothing, and remain out of the direct sun; elderly residents, children, pets, and those with respiratory ailments are said to be particularly susceptible to heat and humidity so they should pay special attention to these suggestions, emergency management officials said.

The five branches of the city library system are open and available as cooling centers during regular hours of operation. In addition, the city's parks 'n' rec department announced extended hours at its pools, splash pads, and Lighthouse Point Park because of the forecast heat index for the rest of the week.
