#### Rules and Guidelines

- The contest is open to adults ages 20+. NHFPL staff are not eligible.
- Each designer may submit only one entry.
- Submissions will be accepted on or before Sunday, February 2, 2020 at 11:59 pm.
- Submissions will be accepted in .jpg format or in hardcopy. The poster should be in portrait orientation and should not measure more than 12" x 18".
- Use any materials and tools (manual or digital) that result in a flat, scannable design.
- Submissions should be brought to the Information Desk at Ives Main Library (133 Elm Street) or emailed to Emily Rush at erush@nhfpl.org
- The poster should express the theme of the contest "Don't Let Them Count You Out"
- Please note, some additional content will be added to the poster above and/or below the main image, including information and logos for the New Haven Free Public Library, the Community Foundation for Greater New Haven, and the U.S. Census.
- Only original artwork will be considered. Copyrighted, trademarked products, packaging, brand names and advertisements may not be used within the poster.

#### **Judging Criteria**

- Submissions will be reviewed by a panel of judges (composed of library staff, local artists, and community members). All decisions are final.
- Entries will be judged on creativity, attractiveness, marketability, and overall impact of the final design.

- First Prize: \$75 (courtesy of Planned Parenthood & NHFPL)
- Eight Runner-up Prizes: \$50 Stop & Shop gift cards (courtesy of the NHFPL)
