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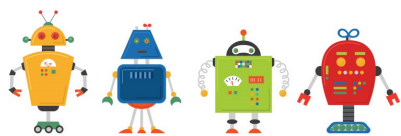

Wednesday, March 4th 4 PM

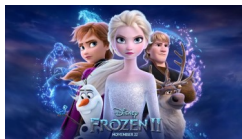
