Curbside Pick-up starts Monday, July 6 at the New Haven Free Public Library!

NEW HAVEN – The New Haven Free Public Library (NHFPL) is pleased to announce curbside pick-up services starting on Monday, July 6.

"We are so excited to be launching NHFPL Curbside pick-up service at all 5 of our library branches," shared John Jessen, City Librarian and Director. "While we have seen enormous increases over the past three months in the usage of our electronic resources - for instance, 108% increase in ebooks and audio books borrowed on OverDrive! - we know that many of our users, just cannot wait for the feel of a book in their hand."

NHFPL Curbside Pick-up

- Curbside pick-up will be available by appointment at all NHFPL locations.
- You can start to request items on Monday, July 6.
- Each patron can request up to 10 books and 5 DVDs at a time.
- Requests will be kept for one week if not picked up as scheduled.
- As a reminder, all library materials currently checked out will be automatically renewed through July 31. There will be no overdue fines.
- Please use the library book drop to return your materials. Returns will not be accepted at the pick-up table.
- No donations are being accepted at this time.
- Returned materials will be quarantined for 72 hours before being placed back in circulation and removed from your account.

How to Request and Schedule Pick Up Library Materials

Step 1: You can place holds in the following ways:

Step 2: Library staff will call you once your holds are filled to schedule a pick-up time. If you cannot be reached by phone, we will send you an email to contact us.

Step 3: Arrive at the library for your appointment, locate the curbside sign, and call the phone number on the sign to pick up your items.

Guidelines for Picking Up Library Materials

- Face masks must be worn at all times when picking up library materials
- Maintain social distancing staying at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people.
- There will be no access to the inside of the building; restrooms are not available.
