Each team member must earn a total of 20 points over the 12 weeks the program runs (June 12, 2021-September 3, 2021)

Earn Points: **READ, WRITE, DO**

Read (a book, e-book, graphic novel, or listen to an audio book)

Write (a book review, poetry, short story, etc.) Do (an activity: attend/view a library program, visit a park or museum, do activities at home, etc.)

Earn Prizes: A chance to win two (2) prizes!!! Finishing teams are entered into a raffle for both:

- One (1) of ten (10) neighborhood branch library prizes from your preferred NHFPL library branch.
- One (1) of six (6) Grand Prizes (Prizes are TBD)
