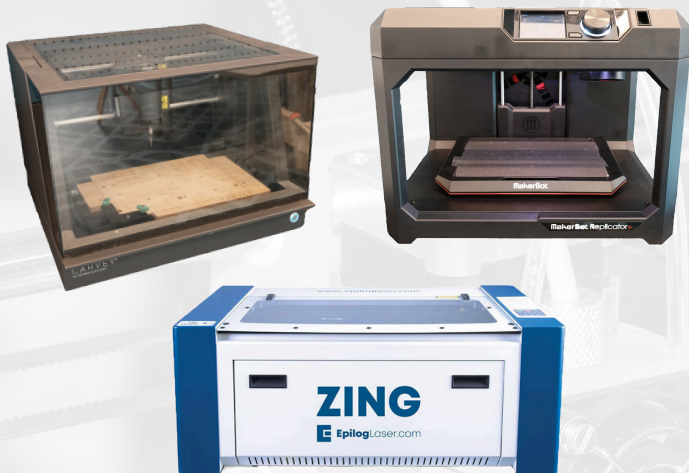

Join us for our Fiber Arts Fundamentals series, where each month we'll make a useful project using a fiber arts skill like sewing, knitting and crochet.

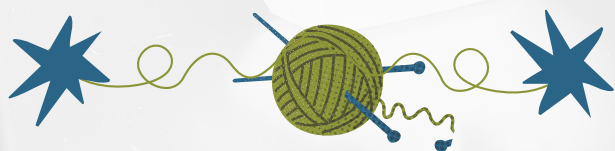
This month you can learn how to sew by hand. We'll show you how to use two basic stitches to make a fleece scarf with pockets at the ends! All supplies will be provided.
